### New Business

### Fund Requests

Virginia Lake presented on behalf of the library. Her request is for the Iowa Children's Choice Award Books for West Elementary. She reported that nominated books are read by students throughout the school year (August – February). Students throughout the state vote on which book they feel deserves the award and it's good for the library to have multiple copies since students in grades 3-6 can participate. The total cost for these books is \$99.44. This fund request was approved unanimously.

Virginia Lake also is requesting funds for the GoldFinch Award Books for East Elementary. Every year the Iowa Association of School librarians puts forth a list of 20 books. Students and teachers throughout Iowa read these nominated books. It is important to have multiple copies as all teachers at East Elementary participate. The total cost for these books is \$93.76. This fund request was approved unanimously.

Helen Lukes presented on behalf of the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade teachers. She is requesting funds for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade field trip to Pizza Hut. Each student who meets the monthly reading goal is awarded a Book It certificate for a personal pan pizza. The students take a bus to Pizza Hut to redeem those certificates. They are asking the PTO to fund the drinks. 2 liter bottles of pop are \$2.99 and they need 2-3 per class. \$30.73 is requested for the January trip. This fund request was approved unanimously.

Finally, the Spring Carnival was briefly discussed members determined that we will advertise as much as we can and put the information on the city and school channel. We will need people to hang up fliers around town.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:35 where the members broke off into their committees for the Spring Carnival.
